In October of last year we received numerous phone calls to our home phone from a lady who introduced herself as Svetlana, the daughter of our acquaintances Alla and Valentin. She wanted to find out from us where her parents, Alla and Valentin, were. Moreover, she was convinced that they have been staying at our place for some time, and we were trying to hide this fact from her. Every time she called, both my husband and I replied that we were not aware where her parents were staying. She was so sure that we were lying, that Svetlana tried to threaten us that she'll go to authorities. In this case it was Barrie police, i.e. that if we are hiding Alla and Valentin in our house, then next time we'll be dealing with the police. Svetlana tried to convey to me that her parents are mentally and psychologically ill, and she tried to convey to me that I am counting on some money from her parents, and she warns me that if I do so or help her parents, I'll regret. Svetlana asked a lot of questions regarding whether I know for how much her parents sold their apartment in St. Petersburg, Russia. The conversation was extremely unpleasant and I asked Svetlana to stop disturbing me. I told her that if I find out where her parents are, I'll let her know. I advised her to contact the police if she wanted to find her parents or at least find out if they are OK.

I have children and would ask you not to call me to court as a witness if it comes to that. But I am glad I can provide this letter to support Alla and Valentin's case.
